Seminary of Our Lady

Saligao - Pi/erne Goa A BRIEF HISTORY

The Seminary of Our Lady, Saligaoj-Pilerne was the dream of Archbishop-Patriarch D, Teotonio Vieira de Castro (1931-1940). He thought of building a new Seminary that would be large enough to accommodate 400 to 500 seminarians. Prior to that, the Minor-Seminarians, who were also known as "external students", lived in rented houses, known as "Comensalidades", around the Patriarchal Seminary of Rachol and even at Mapusa, in North Goa. The foundation stone of the new Seminary was blessed by the Patriarch himself and laid by Major Higino Craveiro Lopes, incharge of the State Government, on the 8th December, 1937, in the presence of a distinguished gathering and a large crowd of people.

Due to the Second World War and the paucity of funds and materials, the work made very slow progress, until Patriarch, D. Jose da Costa Nunes, the successor of D. Teotonio, sent an appeal to all to donate generously towards the construction of the new Seminary. The project received a great boost when a large donation was made by the Portuguese Government, through the good offices of Patriarch Costa Nunes, followed by other donations. And the pace of the construction accelerated. Fr. Paulo Arcanjo de Menezes, from Sangolda, supervised the construction work of the Seminary with great zeal and dedication. The interior work of the old wing of the Seminary (e.g. tiling, etc) was completed by Fr. Inacio Lourenço Pereira of Albutriel (Diocese of Leiria, Portugal) at the request of D. Jose da Costa Nunes.

His Eminence Cardinal Manuel Gonsalves Cerejeira, Patriarch of Lisbon and Legate 'a latere' of His Holiness Pope Pius XII for the Exposition and fourth centenary celebrations of the death of St. Francis Xavier, inaugurated the First Phase of the original plan of the Seminary, on the 6th of December, 1952.

The Seminary Chapel was dedicated to Our Lady of Rosary of Fatima. Through an Order dated 13th March, 1953, emanating from the Patriarch's Palace, the "Preparatory Course" of Rachol Seminary and the staff teaching it were shifted to the new Seminary of Saligao- Pilerne. The first Academic Year began with a Solemn Session on the 22nd of June, 1953 presided over by the Governor General while the Patriarch of the East Indies was the Guest of Honour. Msgr. Altino Ribeiro de Santana, later Bishop of Sa de Bandeira (Angola) and Beira (Mozambique), was appointed the first Rector of the new Seminary. Just before the Liberation of Goa, the third Rector, Msgr. Raul N. Gonsalves, Archbishop emeritus of Goa and Daman, due to the increasing number of candidates aspiring for priesthood, began the construction of the North wing of the Seminary. The work was completed by Msgr. Alfredo das Angustias Mesquita, the fourth Rector, in 1963. This was the Second Phase of the construction. The Third Phase (North East Wing) is yet to be completed.

The Minor Seminary curriculum was never quite on par with the official school curriculum, being, in some disciplines considerably superior to the latter. Consequently, students leaving the Seminary would face difficulties in getting integrated (or re-integrated) in the school curriculum. To obviate this difficulty the syllabi for Std: VIII, IX and X of the Secondary School, prescribed by the Goa Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education, were introduced in the Seminary. Thus came to existence the Seminary of Our Lady High School, recognized by the Government of Goa and the Goa Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education in 1976, due to the persistent efforts of the fifth Rector, Fr. Cromancio Mascarenhas and the Diocesan Society of Education. Right from the time of its recognition, this School has won laurels due to its good results at the Board examinations, which is a testimony to the high standards demanded by the teachers from the students of this Seminary.

During the tenure of the sixth Rector, Rev. Fr. Manuel Pinto do Rosario, the construction of an appropriate building for the "Seminary Niwas" at Duler, Mapusa was successfully completed. Niwas serves as a residence to our Minor Seminarians pursuing higher secondary education in St. Xavier's Higher Secondary School, Mapusa, run by the Archdiocese of Goa.

In the six decades of its existence, hundreds of students have passed through the portals of this Seminary, some of whom became priests, while others work in different capacities in Goa and elsewhere.

The red-letter day in the annals of the Seminary was when one of its alumini, Rev. Filipe Neri Ferrao, was chosen as the Auxiliary Bishop of Goa and Daman on the 25th of Jan 1994. He was ordained Bishop on 10th April, the same year. He was installed as Archbishop of Goa and Daman and Patriarch of East Indies 21st March 2004. Another student, Rev. Anil Joseph Thomas Couto is presently the Archbishop of the Archdiocese of Delhi.

With such a glorious tradition behind us, we launch into the 67th Year of the existence and ministry of this our beloved Seminary with full trust in God,— whose love urges us on to form young boys unto Christ— and under the patronage of our Heavenly Mother, Mary.

Seminary Life

"In minor seminaries founded to nurture the seeds of vocation, students should be prepared by a special religious formation and, specially, by suitable spiritual direction, to follow Christ the Redeemer with generous souls and pure hearts." (Decree on Priestly Training, `OptatamTotius' of Vatican. Council II)

- The Seminarians shall join the Seminary on the day and at the time stipulated by the Seminaryauthorities. They shall be inside by 5.30pm.
- 2. Newly admitted Seminarians shall furnish the following documents:
 - a. Application to Archbishop-Patriarch expressing their desire to join the Seminary
 - b. Baptism Certificate
 - c. Confirmation Certificate, if Sacrament of Confirmation has been received
 - d. Marks sheet & School Leaving Certificate
 - e. Fitness Certificate from a Registered Medical Practitioner
 - f. Character Certificate from the Parish Priest
 - g. Copy of the Aadhaar Card
- 3. Every student shall have two sets of daily school uniform and one set of formal uniform consisting of a white shirt, black pants, black shoes and socks. School uniform includes blue/white tennis shoes with white socks which are to be compulsorily worn from 1September onwards or as directed by the Headmaster of the school. During the rainy season the students shall wear sandals
- 4. The students are expected to converse among themselves in English in the classroom as well as outside it. They shall strive to deepen their knowledge of English and Konkani through appropriate reading. Hence, Reading of Library books is a must.
- 5. They shall punctually abide by the time-table as-given on their calendar and strictly observe the discipline of the house..Discipline is a joint effort of all. Hence, they shall avoid loitering in the corridors, dormitories or study halls, as the case may be, after the bell is given or in the refectory once the meals are over.

- 6. The earmarked periods of silence should be rigorously adhered to and the students shall profitably use the time to do their lessons. Also, they shall devoutly participate in all the spiritual exercises.
- 7. They shall maintain personal cleanliness. They shall strive to keep their dormitories, study-halls, classrooms, corridors and all other public places clean and avoid littering.
- 8. The students are expected to be honest, self controlled, respectful, studious, prayerful and engage in all the physical activities such as games, etc, and also in manual labour as directed by those who are in charge.
- 9. Each section has a prefect and the students should respect him and give all cooperation for the maintenance of cleanliness, discipline and punctuality in the division.
- 10. Besides the Day with the family and other stipulated vacations, the students will not be allowed to go home save to attend weddings of siblings, or in case of grave sickness or death of a close relative, for which the parents will have to seek the permission of the authorities. The parents shall inform the respective Prefect who will assess the request and accordingly inform the Rector who alone is the authority to grant leave.
- 11. Students should refrain from entertaining anyone, be their family, friends or even ex-students of this Seminary, in their dormitories or study halls. In no way should the outsiders be brought up to the first floor or anywhere else. They should meet them in the parlour only with due permission of the Prefect.

Since the formation of the Seminarians and the important and delicate task of discerning their vocation continue also during holidays, the Seminarians are given the following guidelines which may help them to spend their holidays in a befitting manner under the leadership and supervision of their parish priest and the guidance of their parents.

I. PRAYER LIFE

They are expected and strongly recommended:

a. To participate in the daily celebration of the Holy Eucharist.

- b. To spend some time everyday before JESUS in the Blessed Sacrament.
- c. To experience HIM in the daily meditation on God's word.
- d. To frequently receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
- e. To say the daily Rosarytogether with their family members.
- f. To remain faithful to other daily spiritual duties, like Morning and Night Prayer, Angelus, Spiritual and Bible Reading, Examination of Conscience, etc.

II. APOSTOLATE

- a. It goes without saying that the Seminarians should spend their time with their parents and dear ones at home and render them all possible help and assistance in their domestic work and show them love and affection in every possible way.
- b. As far as possible, they should participate in the religious services held in their Church and help their Parish Priests, specially in teaching Catechism as and when required.
- c. They are recommended to be involved in whatever social activities that may be organized by the parish. It will be highly appreciated if they visit and help the sick, the poor, the aged and the suffering in their village.
- d. It is strongly desired that, with their spirit of faith, love and obedience, habits of discipline and order, they influence their siblings, peers and friends to live a truly Christian life.

III. WITNESS

Wherever they may be and whatever they may do, the Seminarians are expected to be 'light of the world' and 'the salt of the earth' and thus be true witnesses of Christ. They should learn to prize those qualities which are highly regarded among men, such as sincerity of heart, a constant concern for justice, fidelity in one's word, courtesy of manner, restraint and kindliness in speech (0.T.II)

IV. OTHER ACTIVITIES

Since idleness leads to evil,

- a. The Seminarians are reminded that they should devote some time to their studies and utilize their leisure time in useful hobbies, such as reading good books and magazines that may help them to enrich their knowledge and culture.
- b. While we recommend that they take part in educational and cultural programmes, they are also strongly advised to keep away from unhealthy entertainment, books and periodicals and, above all, company which may appear dangerous in any way.
- c. They are encouraged to play outdoor and indoor games, do physical exercises and manual work every day to create in themselves an appreciation for the dignity of labour.
- d. While it is taken for granted that each and every Seminarian will meet his Parish Priest at the beginning of his holiday and before returning to the Seminary, he is also required to get from his Parish Priest a letter regarding his conduct during the holidays,.

V. RECOMMENDATION TO PARENTS / GUARDIANS

- 1. The parents may visit their wards preferably on Sundays any time between 02.00 and 5.00 pm. However, the students should not miss the classes that may be conducted on Sundays and the parents will have to wait till the classes are over or release them to attend the classes. However, they should refrain from visiting their wards too often.
- 2. If they wish, they may meet the Rector on any Sunday when visiting their wards. On any other day, a prior appointment may be made.
- 3. Parents are requested not to ring up the Seminary except in urgent cases. Seminarians will not be normally called to the phone. Any change in address or phone number should be immediately intimated to the Seminary office.
- The parents/guardians, are the real educators of their children. TheSeminary is the helper and plays a complementary role in the matter. They should, therefore, involve themselves in their children's

work, be interested in their formation and give the Seminary Authorities a helping hand in educating the child efficiently.

- 4. Parents/guardians are expected to do their part in inculcating regular work habits and discipline in their children. However, nobody can be expected to study profitably without proper relaxation, recreation and games. Hence, parents/guardians should encourage their sons/wards to participate in the numerous co-curricular activities organized in the Seminary.
- 5. Youth today have to face problems and difficulties different from those some years ago. Therefore, parents/guardians should encourage their sons/wards to confide in them with their problems/doubts. They should give their children/wards time. The children must feel that their parents are genuinely interested in their growth and well-being.
- 6. Parents are requested to come to the Seminary whenever called, either by the Seminary authorities or the teachers. They should especially make it a point to come to collect their son/s/ward's report whenever called.
- 7. Parents/guardians should bring to the notice of the Rector any complaints that they may have.
- 8. Parents/guardians and others may not meet the students or the teachers during school hours without the express permission of the Rector. Teachers can be contacted only when they have a free period or outside class schedule. An appointment made in advance will be highly appreciated. Parents should meet their wards in the parlour only unless they wish to meet the Prefect or Rector or have work in the Office.
- 9. Parents and guardians must realise that their help and co-operation is needed for their children to get the full benefit of the training given to them in the Seminary.
- 10. The Seminary Authorities reserve the right to either admit or denyadmission to any student and it may be borne in mind that no one has a right to dictate to the Seminary authorities. The Seminary Authorities also reserve the right to ask any Seminarian to leave the Seminary if it is felt that his conduct is unsatisfactory or his influence is detrimental to other seminarians.
